Scholarships are available to graduating seniors of Bamberg American High School.

Eligibility:

1. Seniors graduating in June 2009 from Bamberg American High School.
2. Parent or guardian must be assigned/attached to a unit at Warner Barracks in Bamberg.
3. Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA at the end of your first semester of your senior year.
4. Students who have accepted a full scholarship of any type are eligible to apply.

Requirements

1. Completed application
2. Transcript with GPA from Bamberg American High School
3. Acceptance letter from an accredited college or university
4. Written verification for awards, honors, volunteer hours (i.e., certificates of achievement, gold awards, letters from teachers/coaches, letters from organizations, etc.)
5. An essay not to exceed two typed pages.
6. At least one letter of recommendation

Instruction on completing application packet:

1. Read all instructions and attached evaluation criteria before completing
2. Type or legibly print all information, essay must be typed
3. Essay topic is "Why I Would like to Continue My Education".
4. Attach transcript, college acceptance letter, verification of awards, volunteer hours, letters of recommendation, list of extra-curricular activities, and any other pertinent information to your application.
5. Remember, it is your responsibility to ensure your application packet is complete and turned into the correct person by the deadline below.

DUE DATE:

Completed applications are due no later than Friday, May 1, 2009, to your school guidance counselor. Incomplete applications will not be accepted or considered.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

Scholarship awards will be announced at the annual after the May Board Meeting of the BSCC, usually at the annual Bamberg High School Awards Assembly. At that time, if chosen to receive a scholarship, you will receive a letter for your college registrar instructing them to notify the BSCC in writing as soon as you have a registered full-time student. When the BSCC receives the notification, the Treasurer will issue a check to the business office of your educational institution to be applied to your tuition, fees and other expenses.
